- 1. The primary payouts go to the boat with the heaviest flounder weighed.
- 2. The one fishing day is Saturday, August 22, 2015.
- 3. There are no checkouts and no boundaries except CP&L Intake and Sunny Point. Tournament based on the **HONOR** system.
- 4. Fish must be caught during tournament hours. No lines in the water until after 7:00 a.m.
- 5. All boats must be in line at the green and red buoys at the mouth of Southport Marina by 5:00 p.m. Scales will open at 3:00 p.m. at Southport Marina. No weigh-ins allowed before 3:00 p.m.
- 6. All fish weighed in will become the property of the Sheriff Ingram's Flatfish Roundup.
- 7. A boat may only win one primary prize, but they may win more than one secondary prize. The **Junior Angler** must be 14 years of age or younger and must accompany the fish to the scales. Anyone 14-years-old or younger is automatically considered a junior angler. This prize is based on the single heaviest flounder. The **Lady Angler** must accompany the fish to the scales. This prize is based on the single heaviest flounder. The **Senior Angler** must be at least 55 years of age and must accompany the fish to the scales. Any male 55-years-old or older is automatically a senior angler. This prize is based on the single heaviest flounder.
- 8. All protests made to the tournament committee shall be accompanied by a \$200 cash deposit. All protests shall be made no later than one hour after the last fish has been weighed. The \$200 cash deposit will be returned if the tournament committee upholds the protest. The \$200 cash deposit will become the property of the Sheriff Ingram's Flatfish Roundup if the protest is not upheld. All decisions of the tournament committee shall be final.
- 9. The TWTs (tournament within a tournament)—Calcutta, High Roller Biggest Flounder, and Red Drum—all have a payouts based on number of boat entry for that TWT. Participants in the tournament are not required to enter the TWTs. They are offered as another way for you to win money. Fish weighed must adhere to all local, state, and federal laws.
- 10. Prizes are awarded solely on the basis of fish weight. In the event of identical weights, the first fish weighed shall be declared the winner.
- 11. All fish must be caught on hook and line and from the registered boat. All fish will be received and inspected by the terms of the weigh master. No cut or mutilated fish will be accepted.
- 12. All fish must be weighed in from the boat in which they were caught. No overland transport to the weigh station will be allowed, and a crewmember must accompany the fish to the scales.
- 13. By signing the entry form, the captain and crew, etc. consent that Sheriff Ingram's Flatfish Roundup may use without payment or restrictions any photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose whatsoever, including but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial, or promotional material.
- 14. All captains and crew members are responsible for reading and following all rules and regulations set forth by the Sheriff Ingram's Flatfish Roundup.
